



### ***A formal University Appointment is now available for Clinical Supervisors***

In recognition of exceptional dedication to the clinical education of students of McGill's School of Physical and Occupational Therapy (SPOT), the School would like to offer clinical supervisors a formal appointment at McGill University, entitled, ***Faculty Lecturer (nil salary)***. This position is for a duration of three years, and, although not remunerated, it gives access to the electronic system of McGill Libraries, free of charge.

***Faculty Lectureship (nil salary)*** replaces prior recognition, entitled: ***Professional Associate***, which, since Sept 1, 2010, no longer exists as a classification.

**Criteria:** To be eligible for this appointment, clinical supervisors must commit to supervising a minimum of five (5) students over the three-year term of the appointment. In addition, Faculty Lecturers are strongly encouraged to contribute at least once per year to an instructional activity. This could include, for example, either providing a lecture within a course; practical instruction or facilitation within a lab; facilitating a small group teaching session or clinical reasoning workshop; participation as an OSCE examiner; or as an interprofessional education (IPE) facilitator.
