

Isabelle Ganache completed a Ph.D. in bioethics at the Université de Montréal in 2006. She then pursued her interest in the integration of ethics at the Agence d'évaluation des technologies et des modes d'intervention en santé (AETMIS) in a project related to genetic policy. At the Commissaire à la santé et au bien-être (2007-2016), she participated in the evaluation of the performance of the health and social services system and actualized a vision of ethics related to citizen and stakeholder participation. Member and chair of ethics committees from 2002 to 2014, she also has an expertise in responsible conduct of research. Since 2012, Isabelle has been a clinical assistant professor in the bioethics programs at the Université de Montréal. Before acting as a senior scientific professional in ethics at INESSS, since 2016, she was member of the Standing Scientific Committee on Health and Social Services of the organization(2011-2016). Since 2017, she is the scientific coordinator of the "Methodology, Ethics and Participation" Unit of the Vice Presidency of Science and Clinical Governance.
